Abstract: H. Glenn Buffington was an avid supporter of aviation and women pilots. He amassed an extensive collection of aviation which reflects his interests, from the early National Air Races to more current events.

During WWII, Glenn served as a flight radio operator. Boeing hired him after the war as a test flight technician and executive aid for 36 years. His collection contains many notebooks in which he kept copious notes about aviation events he attended, pilots he met, and interviews he did; an assortment of photographs of pilots, airplanes, and airports; correspondence to and from women pilots; articles written by Glenn for a variety of aviation publications which includes biographies of women pilots. There is also a substantial collection of books on a variety of aviation subjects.

Biography of H. Glenn Buffington

Harold Glenn Buffington, known as *Buff* by his friends, was born in Bismarck, North Dakota on September 11, 1917. The youngest of four children, Buff grew up in the Midwest. His father Charles worked for the railroad which required the family to live in Manilla, Iowa for part of the year and the rest of the year Kansas City.



As a young boy, Buff was fascinated with flying. His mother, Inez, often took him to Kansas City's Fairfax Airport to watch the planes. She finally agreed to let him go up in a plane but wasn't too keen on the male pilots, believing they weren't trustworthy. When Nora White, a charter member of the Ninety-Nines, visited the airfield one day, she gave her fourteen-year-old son permission to fly with Nora in her OX-5 Waco. That was in 1931. Six years later, he made his first solo flight at Fairfax in a Taylor Cub. He later joined Northwest Airlines and flew as a flight radio operator on Northwest's air transport routes over Canada and Alaska during WWII. In 1943, Buff hired on with the Boeing Company as a production flight test technician and, later, served as an executive aide.

When he retired in 1980, he continued flying his own aircraft and wrote occasionally for publications in several aviation and feature magazines. He maintained

memberships in many aviation organizations and serve as an advisor for the Ninety-Nines Resource Center in Oklahoma City and the International Women's Air and Space Museum in Cleveland.

That first flight with the woman pilot inspired Buff to learn more about pioneering women pilots. He began to collect articles and newspaper clippings about those women. His current collection of those articles and those he's written, autographs, and photographs of the women pilots and aviation is considered one of the most extensive collections of the history of women's involvement in aviation. Over the years, Buff became personal friends with many of the women pilots and attended their events. The Ninety-Nines, an international organization of women pilots, presented with Buff with the Award of Merit for his dedication to preserving their history.

Scope and Content

The H. Glenn Buffington Collection, 1928-2008, is a comprehensive body of documentary evidence reflecting the history of women pilots, from pioneers to contemporary flyers. It consists of newspaper and magazine clippings, Glenn's personal notebooks, correspondence, articles written by Glenn, photographs, and an assortment of aviation memorabilia. It is stored in approximately 33 boxes in the Museum of Women Pilots Collection Room. The only exception is a collection of aviation-related books held in the museum library.

The Collection is useful for researching the lives and achievements of women pilots beginning with the pioneers during the 'birth' of aviation and ending with contemporary flyers, including astronauts. The Collection also encompasses a comprehensive history of the Ninety-Nines, the Powder Puff Derbys, the All Women's Transcontinental Air Races, the early Air Race Classics, and other women's air races. Lists of contestants and race results are to be found as well as biographical information on the fliers.

Statement of Arrangement

The Collection is arranged in four series. **Series I** is composed of letter-size file boxes which contain folders arranged by Accession Number. Fourteen boxes hold three to four files while others made hold up to 30 files depending upon size of each folder. These folders primarily contain information of women pilots. Four additional boxes contain film canisters and an extensive amount of letters written to Buffington. **Series II** consists of 12 large boxes containing notebooks, scrapbooks, artifacts, and papers. **Series III** contains framed paintings, pictures, and awards. **Series IV** is a large collection of books located in the museum library.
